

TimerTrac.com Annual Champions Throttle Major Indexes in 2007: Markets Performance Anemic Next to Active Managers' 30% to 57%

For 2007, following Nasdaq Wizard's recommendations for trading the Nasdaq 100 with the QQQQ's would have yielded 49.97% (vs. the NDX 100's annual standing of 18.67%) and for the Russell 2000, following Nasdaq Wizard would have yielded 56.65% (vs. the RUT index, -2.75%).

IndexTrades.net significantly beat both the S&P 500 and the Dow Jones 30 performance for the year: 37.54% (vs. the S&P's 3.53%), and for the Dow, IndexTrades.net reaped 30.59% (vs. the DJIA's 6.43%).
